*(Selection 9)* Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

## **CALL TO WORSHIP** *(Selection 21 – Christmas)*

Minister: The people who walked in darkness have seen a  
great light;

**People: Those who lived in a land of deep darkness –  
on them light has shined.**

Minister: For a child has been born for us,

**People: a son given to us;**

Minister: authority rests upon his shoulders,

**People: and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Might  
God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.**

Minister: For see – I am bringing you good news of great  
joy for all the people:

**People:** to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord.

**CALL TO WORSHIP** (*Selection 22 – Lent*)

**Minister:** With what shall I come before the Lord.

**People:** and bow myself before God on high?

**Minister:** God has showed you what is good;

**People:** and what does the Lord require of you

**Minister:** But to do justice, to love kindness,

**People:** and to walk humbly with your God?

**CALL TO WORSHIP** (*Selection 23 – Easter*)

**Minister:** Alleluia! Christ is risen.

**People:** The Lord is risen indeed. Alleluia!

**Minister:** So if you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above.

**People:** Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

**CALL TO WORSHIP** (*Selection 24 – Pentecost*)

Minister: Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts;  
People: **the whole earth is full of God's glory.**

Minister: O give thanks to the Lord, for the Lord is good;  
People: **God's steadfast love endures forever.**

Minister: Let us therefore approach the throne of grace  
with boldness,  
People: **so that we may receive mercy and find grace to  
help in time of need.**

### **CALL TO WORSHIP** (*Selection 25 – Thanksgiving*)

Minister: The Lord is good to all,  
People: **and shows compassion to all creation.**

Minister: The eyes of all look to you,  
People: **and you give them their food in due season.**

Minister: You open your hand,  
People: **and you satisfy the desire of all living things.**

### **CALL TO WORSHIP** (*Selection 26 – General*)

Minister: Lift up your hearts,  
People: **We lift them up to the Lord.**

Minister: O Lord, open our eyes,

**People: That we may behold wondrous things out of your law.**

Minister: O Lord, open our lips,

**People: And our mouths will declare your praise.**

Minister: Praise the Lord.

**People: The Lord's name be praised.**

Minister: Holy and beautiful the custom which brings us together

**People: in the presence of the most high:**

Minister: Through this quiet hour breathes the worship of ages,

**People: the heritage of generations past.**

Minister: Three unseen guests attend,

**People:** faith, hope, and love.

Minister: Let all our hearts prepare them place.

**CALL TO WORSHIP** (*Selection 28 – General*)

Minister: O come, let us sing to the Lord;

**People:** Let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

Minister: For great is the Lord,

**People:** And greatly to be praised.

Minister: Let your steadfast love, O Lord, be upon us.

**People:** Even as we hope in you.



## **BENEDICTIONS** *(Selection 30)*

Minister: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all evermore.

Minister: The peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in the knowledge and love of God, and of Jesus Christ our Lord; and the blessing of God, Creator, Redeemer and Sustainer, be among you and remain with you always.

Minister: Unto God's gracious mercy and protection we entrust you. The Lord bless you and keep you. The Lord be kind and gracious to you. The Lord look upon you with favor and give you peace, both now and forever.

Minister: The Lord bless you in your loneliness, the Lord console you in your anxiety, the Lord forgive you in your guilt, the Lord be with you in your despair, the Lord meet in mercy all those who seek peace.

Minister: Go in peace, and in the knowledge that in the goodness of God you were born, in the providence of God you are kept all the day

long, and in the mercy and forgiveness of God you are redeemed and made whole; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Minister: May the truth which makes us free, the hope that never dies, and the love which casts out fear, visit us and redeem us, till the day-spring breaks and the shadows flee away.

Minister: Go forth into the world in peace; be of good courage; hold fast that which is good; render to no one evil for evil; strengthen the fainthearted; support the weak; help the afflicted; honor all people. Love and serve the Lord rejoicing the power of the Holy Spirit.

## RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 8 *(Selection 31)*

Minister: O Lord, our Sovereign, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

**People: Out of the mouths of babes and infants your majesty is praised above the heavens.**

Minister: You have founded a bulwark because of your foes, to silence the enemies and the avenger.

**People: When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars you have set in their courses.**

Minister: What are human beings that you are mindful of them? Mortals that you care for them?

**People: You have made them a little lower than God, and crowned them with glory and honor.**

Minister: You give them dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under their feet:

**People: All sheep and oxen, and also the beasts of the field,**

Minister: The birds of the air, and the fish of the sea, whatever passes along the paths of the seas.

**People: O Lord, our Sovereign, how majestic is your name in all the earth!**

## RESPONSIVE READING – Psalms 9-10 *(Selection 32)*

Minister: I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will tell of your wonderful deeds.

**People: I will be glad and exult in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.**

Minister: It is the Lord who rules the world with righteousness and judges the people with equity.

**People: The Lord is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in time of trouble.**

Minister: For the needy shall not always be forgotten, nor the hope of the poor perish forever.

**People: Rise up, O Lord; O God, lift up your hand; do not forget the oppressed.**

Minister: But you do see! Indeed you note trouble and grief, that you may take it into your own hands.

**People: The helpless commit themselves to you, you have been the helper of the orphan.**

Minister: The Lord will hear the desire of the meek; you will strengthen their heart, you will incline your ear

**People: To do justice for the orphan and the oppressed, so that those from earth may strike**

**terror no more.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 18 *(Selection 33)*

Minister: I love you, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer,

**People: my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.**

Minister: I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, so shall I be saved from my enemies.

**People: The cords of the grave encompassed me; , the torrents of perdition assailed me;**

Minister: The cords of the grave entangled me; and the snares of death confronted me.

**People: In my distress I called upon the Lord; to my God I cried for help.**

Minister: The Lord reached down from on high, and took me, and drew me out of many waters.

**People: The Lord delivered me from my strong enemy, and from those who hated me; for they were too mighty for me.**

Minister: They confronted me in the day of my calamity; but the Lord was my support.

**People: The Lord lives! Blessed be my rock! Exalted be the God of my salvation, the God who**

**gave me victory.**

**Minister:** You delivered me from my enemies; you  
exalted me above my adversaries; you saved  
me from the violent.

**People:** For this I will extol you, O Lord, among the  
nations, and sing praises to your name.

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 19 *(Selection 34)*

Minister: The heavens are telling the glory of God; and  
the firmament proclaims God's handiwork.

**People: Day to day pours forth speech, and night to  
night declares knowledge.**

Minister: There is no speech, nor are there words; their  
voice is not heard; yet their voice goes out  
through all the earth, and their words to the  
end of the world.

**People: The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the  
soul;**

Minister: the decrees of the Lord are sure, making wise  
the simple;

**People: the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the  
heart;**

Minister: the commandment of the Lord is clear,  
enlightening the eyes;

**People: the fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever;**

Minister: The ordinances of the Lord are true and  
righteous altogether.

**People: More to be desired are they than gold, even  
much fine gold, sweeter also than honey, and  
drippings of the honeycomb.**



Minister: Moreover by them is thy servant warned; in  
keeping them there is great reward.

**People: But who can discern his errors? Clear thou me  
from hidden faults.**

Minister: Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous  
sins; let them not have dominion over me!  
Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great  
transgression.

**People: Let the words of my mouth and the meditation  
of my heart be acceptable to you, O Lord, my  
rock and my redeemer.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 23 *(Selection 35)*

Minister: The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want;

**People: He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters;**

Minister: He restores my soul; he leads me in paths, for his name's sake.

**People: Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil;**

Minister: For thou art with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

**People: You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;**

Minister: You anoint my head with oil, my cup overflows.

**People: Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 25 *(Selection 36)*

Minister: To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul; my God, in  
you I trust,

**People: Let me not be put to shame; do not my  
enemies exult over me.**

Minister: Make me to know thy ways, O Lord, teach me  
thy paths.

**People: Lead me in thy truth, and teach me, for you are  
the God of my salvation; for you I wait all the  
day long.**

Minister: Be mindful of your mercy, O Lord, and of your  
steadfast love, for they have been from of old.

**People: Do not remember the sins of my youth, or my  
transgressions; according to your love  
remember me, for your goodness' sake, O  
Lord.**

Minister: Turn to me, and be gracious to me; for I am  
lonely and afflicted.

**People: Relieve the troubles of my heart, and bring me  
out of my distresses.**

Minister: Consider my affliction and my trouble, and  
forgive all my sins.

**People: O guard my life, and deliver me; do not let me**

**be put to shame, for I take refuge in you.**

Minister: May integrity and uprightness preserve me, for  
I wait for you.

**People: Redeem Israel, O God, out of all its troubles.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 27 *(Selection 37)*

Minister: The Lord is my light and my salvation;  
whom shall I fear?

**People: The Lord is the stronghold of my life;  
of whom shall I be afraid?**

Minister: Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud,  
be gracious to me and answer me!

**People: "Come," my heart says,  
"Seek God's face."  
Your face, Lord, do I seek.**

Minister: Do not cast me off, do not forsake me,  
O God of my salvation!

**People: Though my father and mother forsake me,  
the Lord will take me up.**

Minister: Teach me your way, O Lord;  
and lead me along a level path,  
because of my enemies.

**People: I believe that I shall see  
the goodness of the Lord  
in the land of the living.**

Minister: Wait for the Lord; be strong,  
and let your heart take courage;

**People: wait for the Lord!**

## RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 31 *(Selection 38)*

Minister: In you, O Lord, I seek refuge; do not let me ever be put to shame. In your righteousness deliver me!

**People: Incline your ear to me; rescue me speedily. Be a rock of refuge for me, a strong fortress to save me.**

Minister: You are indeed my rock and my fortress; for your name's sake lead me and guide me.

**People: Into your hand I commit my spirit; for you have redeemed me, O Lord, faithful God.**

Minister: I will exult and rejoice in your steadfast love, because you have seen my affliction, you have taken heed of my adversities,

**People: and have not delivered me into the hand of the enemy; you have set my feet in a broad place.**

Minister: Be gracious to me, O Lord, for I am in distress; my eye wastes away from grief, my soul and my body also.

**People: For my life is spent with sorrow, and my years with sighing; my strength fails because of my misery, and my bones waste away.**

Minister: But I trust in you, O Lord,

**People: I say, "You are my God." My times are in your**

**hand;**

Minister: O how abundant is your goodness that you  
have laid up for those who fear you,

**People: Love the Lord, all you his saints!**

Minister: The Lord preserves the faithful, but abundantly  
requites him who acts haughtily.

**People: Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all  
you who wait for the Lord!**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 42 *(Selection 39)*

Minister: As a deer longs for flowing streams, so longs  
my soul for you, O God.

**People: My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.**

Minister: When shall I come and behold the face of God?

**People: My tears have been my food day and night,  
while people say to me continually, "Where is  
your God?"**

Minister: These things I remember, as I pour out my soul:  
how I went with the throng, and led them in  
procession to the house of God, with glad  
shouts and songs of thanksgiving, a multitude  
keeping festival.

**People: Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why  
are you disquieted within me?**

Minister: Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my  
help and my God.

**People: I will say to God, my rock: "Why hast thou  
forgotten me?"**

Minister: Why go I mourning because the enemy  
oppresses me?"

**People: As with a deadly wound in my body, my  
adversaries taunt me, while they say to me  
continually, "Where is your God?"**



Minister: Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why  
are you disquieted within me?

**People: Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my  
help and my God.**

## RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 46 (*Selection 40*)

Minister: God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

**People: Therefore we will not fear though the earth should change, and though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea;**

Minister: Though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble with its tumult.

**People: There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High.**

Minister: God is in the midst of the city; it shall not be moved; God will help it when the morning dawns.

**People: The nations are in an uproar, the kingdoms totter; God utters his voice, the earth melts away.**

Minister: The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge.

**People: Come, behold the works of the Lord, what desolations have been brought on the earth.**

Minister: It is the Lord who makes wars to cease to the end of the earth; breaking the bow, and shattering the spear, and burning the shields

with fire.

**People:** **“Be still, and know that I am God; I am exalted among the nations, I am exalted in the earth!”**

**Minister:** The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge.

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 51 *(Selection 41)*

Minister: Have mercy on me, O God,  
according to your steadfast love;

**People: according to your abundant mercy, blot out my transgressions.**

Minister: Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity  
and cleanse me from my sin.

**People: For I know my transgressions,  
And my sin is ever before me.**

Minister: Against you, you alone, have I sinned,  
and done what is evil in your sight.

**People: Hide your face from my sins,  
and blot out all my iniquities.**

Minister: Create in me a clean heart, O God,  
and put a new and right spirit within me.

**People: Do not cast me away from your presence  
and do not take your holy spirit from me.**

Minister: Restore to me the joy of your salvation,  
and sustain in me a willing spirit.

**People: O Lord, open my lips,  
and my mouth shall declare your praise.**

Minister: For you have no delight in sacrifice;  
if I were to give a burnt offering,

you would not be pleased.

**People: The sacrifice acceptable to God  
is a broken spirit;  
a broken and contrite heart, O God,  
you will not despise.**

## RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 63 *(Selection 42)*

Minister: O God, you are my God; I seek you,

**People: my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints yearns for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.**

Minister: So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding power and your glory.

**People: Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.**

Minister: So I will bless you as long as I live; I will lift up my hands and call on your name.

**People: When I think of you on my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night, my soul is satisfied as with a rich feast, and my mouth praises you with joyful lips.**

Minister: For you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I sing for joy.

**People: My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.**

## **RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 67** *(Selection 43)*

Minister: May be gracious to us and bless us,

**People: May the light of God's face shine upon us**

Minister: that your way may be known upon earth, your saving power among all nations.

**People: Let the peoples praise you, O God; let all the peoples praise you.**

Minister: Let the nations be glad and sing for joy; for you judge the peoples with equity and guide the nations upon earth.

**People: Let the peoples praise you, O God; let all the peoples praise you.**

Minister: The earth has yielded its increase; God, our God, has blessed us.

**People: May God continue to bless us, let the ends of the earth stand in awe!**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 71 *(Selection 44)*

Minister: In you, O LORD, I take refuge; let me never be put to shame.

**People: In your righteousness deliver me and rescue me; incline your ear to me and save me.**

Minister: Be to me a rock of refuge, a strong fortress to save me; for you are my rock and my fortress.

**People: For you, O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O Lord, from my youth.**

Minister: Upon you I have leaned from my birth; it was you who took me from my mother's womb. My praise is continually of you.

**People: I have been an enigma to many but you are my strong refuge.**

Minister: My mouth is filled with your praise, and with your glory all day long.

**People: Do not cast me off in the time of old age; do not forsake me when my strength is spent.**

Minister: O God, do not be far from me; O my God, make haste to help me!

**People: You who have made me see many troubles and calamities will revive me again; from the depths of the earth you will bring me up again.**



## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 90 *(Selection 45)*

Minister: Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations.

**People: Before the mountains were brought forth, or the land and the earth were born, from age to you are God.**

Minister: You turn us back to the dust and say, "Turn back, you mortals."

**People: For a thousand years in your sight are like yesterday when it is past, or like an hour of the night.**

Minister: So teach us to count our days that we may apply our hearts to wisdom.

**People: Satisfy us in the morning by your steadfast love so that we may sing for joy and be glad all the days of our life.**

Minister: Let your work appear to your servants, and your glorious power to their children.

**People: Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us; and prosper for us the work of our hands.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 95 *(Selection 46)*

Minister: O come let us sing to the Lord;

**People: Let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation.**

Minister: Let us come before the Lord with thanksgiving;

**People: Let us make a joyful noise with songs of praise!**

Minister: For the Lord is a great God, and reigns supreme above all gods.

**People: In God's hand are the caverns of the earth and the heights of the mountains. God also made the sea and molded the dry land.**

Minister: O come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!

**People: For the Lord is our God; we are the people of God's pasture, the sheep of God's hand.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 98 *(Selection 47)*

Minister: Sing to the Lord a new song, for the Lord has done marvelous things.

**People: All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.**

Minister: Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth; break forth and sing for joy and sing praises.

**People: Sing praises to the Lord with the harp, with the harp and the voice of sing.**

Minister: With trumpets and the sound of the horn make a joyful noise before, the King, the Lord.

**People: Let the sea roar and all that fills it, the world and those who live in it.**

Minister: Let the floods clap their hands, and let the hills sing together for joy at the presence of the Lord, for the Lord comes to judge the earth.

**People: The Lord will judge the world with righteousness and the peoples with equity.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 103 *(Selection 48)*

Minister: Bless the Lord, O my soul, it is within me, bless the Lord's holy name.

**People: Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits;**

Minister: Who pardons all your iniquities, and heals all your diseases;

**People: Who redeems your life from the destruction, and crowns you with steadfast love and mercy.**

Minister: The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

**People: The Lord does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.**

Minister: For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is His steadfast love toward those who fear Him.

**People: As far as the east is from the west, so far does the Lord remove our transgressions from us.**

Minister: As for mortals, their days are like grass; they flourish like a flower of the field.

**People: For when the wind passes over it, it is gone, and its place knows it no more.**

Minister: But the steadfast love of the Lord is from  
everlasting to everlasting on those who fear  
him,

**People: The righteousness of the Lord extends to  
children's children, to those who keep the  
Lord's covenant and commandments.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 119 *(Selection 49)*

Minister: Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

**People: I will keep my solemn promise to obey your righteous judgments.**

Minister: I am deeply troubled; preserve my life, O Lord, according to your word.

**People: Accept my offerings of praise, O Lord, and teach me your commandments.**

Minister: My life is always in my hand, yet I do not forget your law.

**People: The wicked have set a trap for me, but I have not strayed from your commandments.**

Minister: Your decrees are my inheritance forever; truly they are the joy of my heart.

**People: I have decided to fulfill your statutes forever and to the end.**

## RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 121 *(Selection 50)*

Minister: I will lift up my eyes to the hills – from where  
will my help come?

**People: My help comes from the Lord, the maker of  
heaven and earth.**

Minister: The Lord will not let your foot be moved; the  
One who watches over you will not fall asleep.

**People: Behold, the keeper of Israel shall neither  
slumber nor sleep.**

Minister: It is the Lord who watches over you; the Lord is  
your shade at your right hand.

**People: So that the sun shall not strike you by day, nor  
the moon by night.**

Minister: The Lord shall preserve you from all evil, and  
shall keep you safe.

**People: The Lord shall watch over your going and

**People:**   **When I became an adult, I put an end to  
                  childish ways.**

Minister: For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we  
                  will see face to face.

**People:**   **Now I know in part; then I will know fully,  
                  even as I have been fully known.**

Minister: And now faith, hope, love abide, these three;

**People:**   **And the greatest of these is love.**
